3. Embed focus upon data collection from Literacy and Numeracy groups for extension and to inform progress.
4. Continue to provide intensive and focussed teaching for all students to improve levels of achievement.
5. Timetabling of support staff and teacher aides must align with classroom management.
6. Embed / develop individual targets for students.
7. Embed / continue strategies to decrease absenteeism ' Every day counts'
